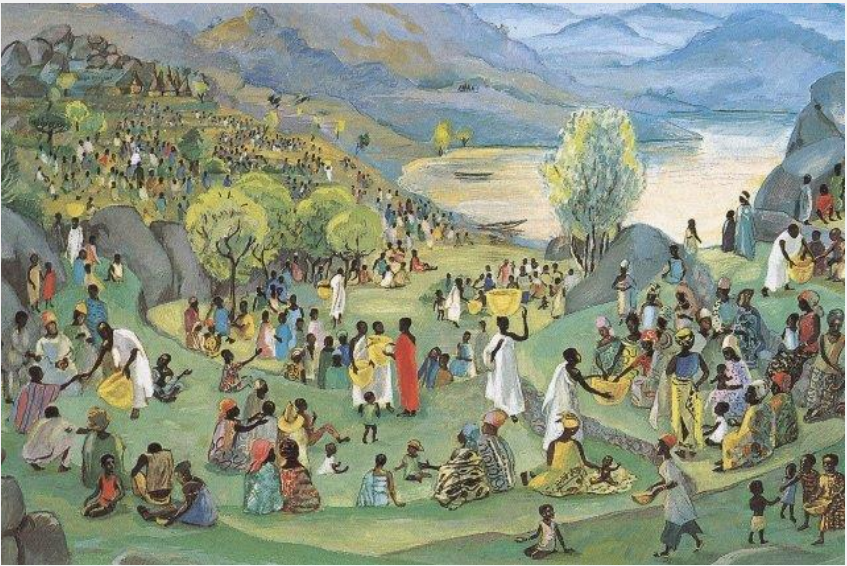

****Affirmation of Faith – Nicene Creed**
