



**Affirmation of Faith - Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen. We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father; through him all things were made. COVID-19 VACCINATIONS

Effective April 7, 2021, the Duke Raleigh Hospital is accepting on a weekly basis requests regarding the COVID-19 vaccination for individuals who are 16 years old and older.

If you, your family members, and/or your friends are eligible and interested in this opportunity, please provide the following information for each person on your list to Maggie and Bill Thomas by Monday at 8 pm each week via email (covidvac4877 gmail.com):

- 1. Full Name
- 2. Birthdate
- 3. Telephone #
- 4. Email Address (if available)
- 5. Residential Address

(Note: All of the above information will be kept confidential and will be shared only with the Duke Raleigh Hospital.)

A Duke Raleigh scheduler will contact each person on the list within 5 business days after the weekly list is submitted to schedule these first vaccinations at a Duke Health location in Raleigh, NC.

On the same day of the first vaccination, if applicable, each person will be informed of the date and time for the second vaccination.
