Jesus Christ clothed himself in our flesh: God and human in one person. We believe that we are illuminated in faith by the unfathomable grace of the Holy Spirit. God imparts this gracious gift. By faith we receive grace to live holy lives in awe and reverence for God, for we receive what the gospel promises when God gives us the Holy Spirit. Faith does not cool our desire for good and holy living, but rather engenders and excites it in us, leading naturally to good works. We believe that the sacraments are joined to the Word in order that the Word may be more fully confirmed. Baptism is given to us as the pledge of our adoption, in which we are grafted into the body of Christ, and renewed in holiness of life by his Spirit. The holy Supper of our Lord is a testimony of our unity with Jesus Christ, who died only once and was raised for our sake. The body and blood of Jesus Christ are food and drink for the soul just as bread and wine are nourishment for the body. As for the true Church we believe that it ought to be governed in accordance with the order established by our Lord Jesus Christ. In this way, pure doctrine can be maintained, the poor and afflicted can be helped in their need, assemblies can be gathered in the name of God, and both great and small can be edified.

COVID-19 VACCINATIONS

The Duke Raleigh Hospital is now administering the COVID-19 vaccination to individuals, who are 12 years old and older; only the Pfizer vaccine is available for individuals who are under 18 years old. To accommodate the requests for vaccinations, the Duke Raleigh Hospital is continuing to provide scheduled appointments at facilities within the Raleigh community. These vaccination appointments can be scheduled via a website by each person requesting a vaccination or by a Duke representative.

If you, your family members, and/or your friends are eligible and interested in scheduling your vaccination appointment via the website, please use the following link to schedule the appointment:

The above vaccination scheduling link allows each person to choose the preferred vaccine (Pfizer, Moderna, or Johnson and Johnson vaccine).

All of the above information will be kept confidential and will be shared only with the Duke Raleigh Hospital. A vaccination scheduler will contact each person within one business day to schedule the vaccination at a Duke Health location in Raleigh, NC.

On the same day of the first vaccination, if applicable, each person will be informed of the date and time for the second vaccination.
