## **COVID-19 VACCINATIONS & BOOSTER SHOTS**

The Duke Raleigh Hospital continues to serve the community by administering the COVID-19 vaccinations to individuals, who are 12 years old or older. Only the Pfizer vaccine is available for individuals under 18 years old.

Also, the Pfizer booster shot is being offered to eligible individuals. Only the Pfizer booster shot is available for individuals, who have been fully vaccinated for six months or more with the Pfizer vaccine and who satisfy at least one of the following criteria:

1. 65 years old or older

2. 18 years old or older with underlying medical conditions
3. Individuals employed in high-risk work environments, such as teachers, healthcare workers, childcare providers, and food workers

To accommodate requests for the COVID-19 vaccination and booster shot, the Duke Raleigh Hospital continues to provide via a website the opportunity to schedule appointments at facilities within the Raleigh community.
